FINANCE & PROPERTY

Over the last two years we have replaced the elderly heating boilers in the Church and in Wesley Hall. Expensive roofing repairs have also been carried out. This, and reduced income from lettings during the pandemic, means that our current reserves are at their lowest level for many years. Fortunately, many people continue to donate to the church each month by standing order so that we have a steady base income – but please review if you can. We continue to give 10% of all our income

(unless given for specific purposes) to a range of charities selected every few years by the Church General Meeting. We have also supported Ukrainian refugees in Poland through connections with a church in Ostroda. £3,000 was given through the church bank account during the 2021 -22 year.

Monday 15th August was the first day of the now annual Adventure Cruise Holiday Club. During the week over 60 primary school age children attended, to hear Bible stories. play games and make wonderful craft items. We've had so many children saying how much they enjoyed learning about Jesus whilst having lots of fun.
